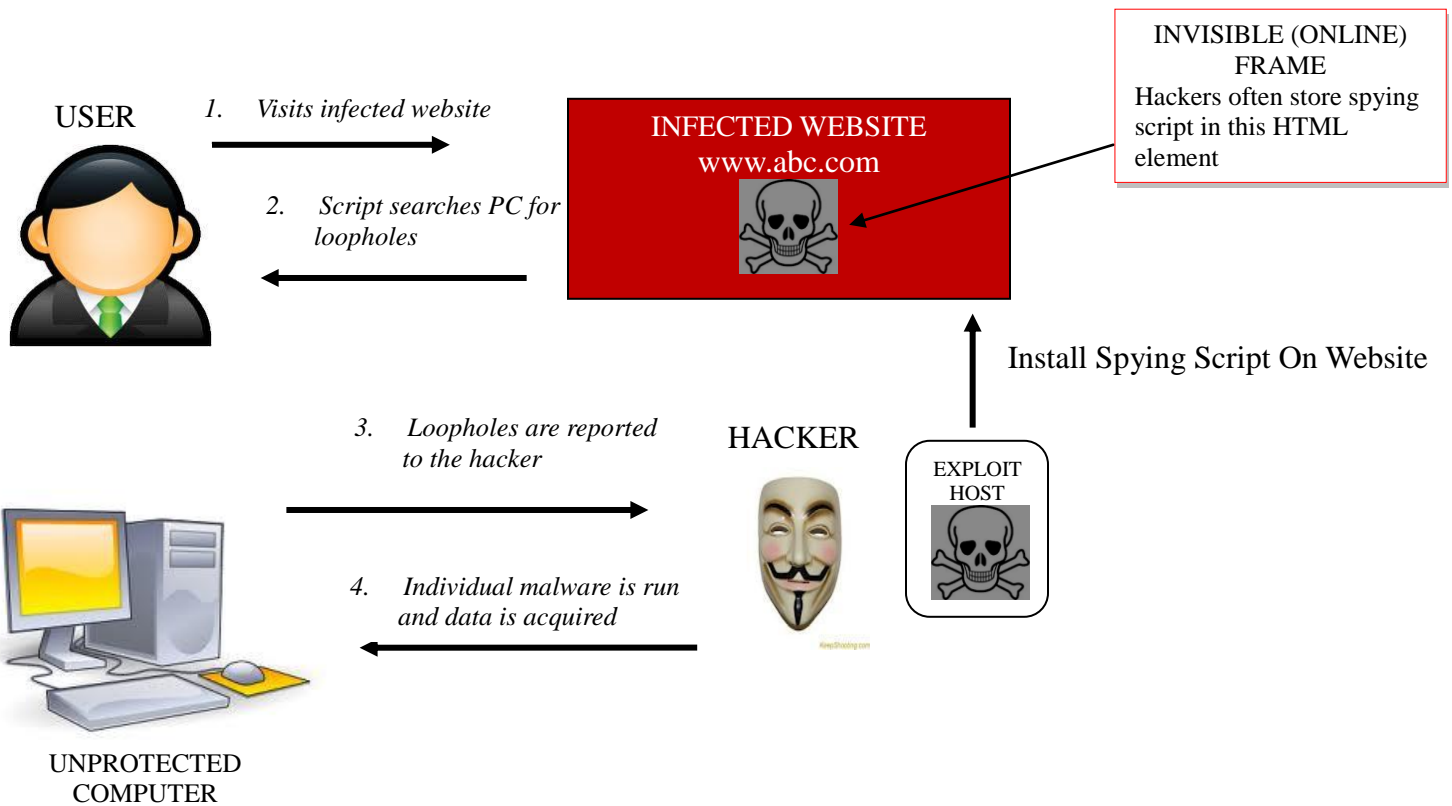


Drive-By Download

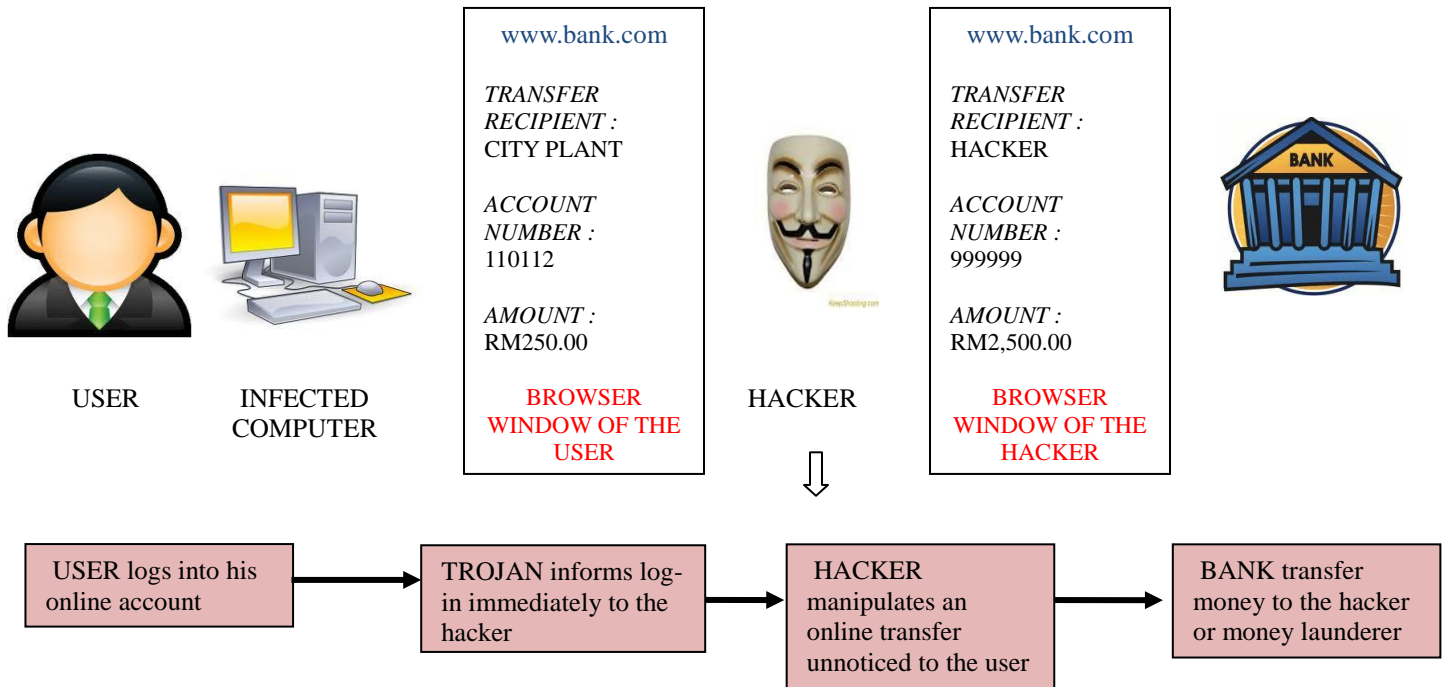

MAN-IN-THE-BROWSER ATTACK
